

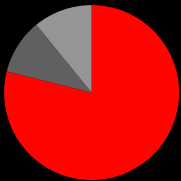

FLORIDA VOTERS SAY THAT PREDICTION MARKETS ARE GAMBLING – NOT INVESTING

79%



Three-in-four Florida voters say that **placing bets on sporting events** through prediction markets is **gambling**.

Republicans	81%

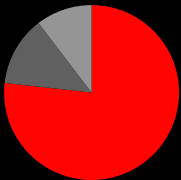
70%



Seven-in-ten Florida voters are **concerned** about insider trading **at the expense of the public** on prediction markets.

Democrats	68%
Independents	68%
Republicans	72%

Three-in-four FL voters are **concerned** that prediction markets will **increase gambling related harms for teenagers**

Republicans	78%
