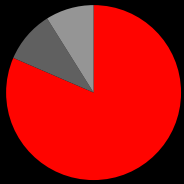

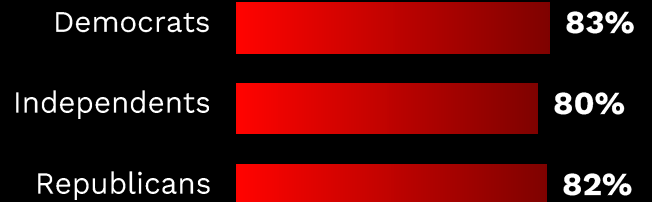


IOWA VOTERS SAY THAT PREDICTION MARKETS ARE GAMBLING – **NOT INVESTING**



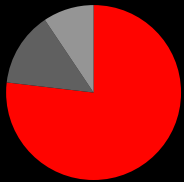

Four-in-five Iowa voters say that **placing bets on sporting events** through prediction markets is **gambling**.



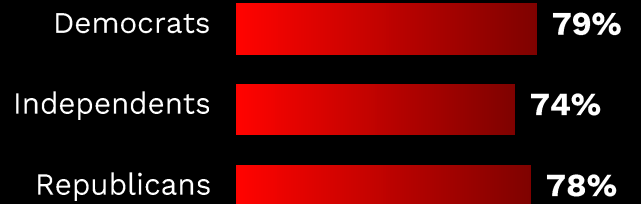
70%
