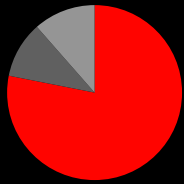

KENTUCKY VOTERS SAY THAT PREDICTION MARKETS ARE GAMBLING – NOT INVESTING



78%

Three-in-four Kentucky voters say that **placing bets on sporting events** through prediction markets is **gambling**.

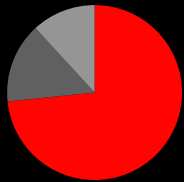
Democrats	79%

Two-in-three Kentucky voters are **concerned** about insider trading **at the expense of the public** on prediction markets.
