

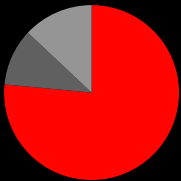

MICHIGAN VOTERS SAY THAT PREDICTION MARKETS ARE GAMBLING – NOT INVESTING

76%



Three-in-four Michigan voters say that **placing bets on sporting events** through prediction markets is **gambling**.

Republicans	79%

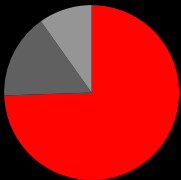
68%



Two-in-three Michigan voters are **concerned** about insider trading **at the expense of the public** on prediction markets.

Democrats	69%
Independents	67%
Republicans	69%
