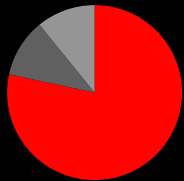

TENNESSEE VOTERS SAY THAT PREDICTION MARKETS ARE GAMBLING – NOT INVESTING



78%

Three-in-four Tennessee voters say that **placing bets on sporting events** through prediction markets is **gambling**.

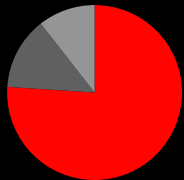
Democrats	76%

Two-in-three Tennessee voters are **concerned** about insider trading **at the expense of the public** on prediction markets.
