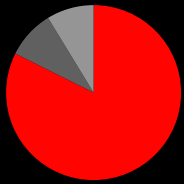

WISCONSIN VOTERS SAY THAT PREDICTION MARKETS ARE GAMBLING – NOT INVESTING



82%

Four-in-five Wisconsin voters say that **placing bets on sporting events** through prediction markets is **gambling**.

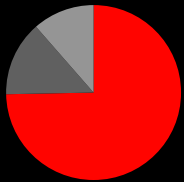
Democrats	82%

Seven-in-ten Wisconsin voters are **concerned** about insider trading **at the expense of the public** on prediction markets.
