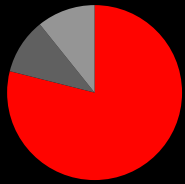

WYOMING VOTERS SAY THAT PREDICTION MARKETS ARE GAMBLING – NOT INVESTING



79%

Three-in-four Wyoming voters say that **placing bets on sporting events** through prediction markets is **gambling**.

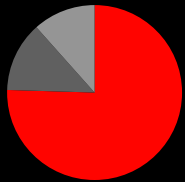
Democrats	78%

Two-in-three Wyoming voters are **concerned** about insider trading **at the expense of the public** on prediction markets.

Democrats	66%
Independents	68%
Republicans	67%

Three-in-four WY voters are **concerned** that prediction markets will **increase gambling related harms for teenagers**.

Democrats	74%
Independents	76%
Republicans	77%
